CompuLaw Further Expands Court Rules Databases with EEOC and FEHA-specific Rule Sets

CompuLaw's EEOC rule set covers deadlines related to the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission's (EEOC) Procedural Regulations as well as California's Fair Employment and Housing Act (FEHA).

CompuLaw's new EEOC rules, United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission - 29 CFR Part 1601, cover charges presented to the EEOC and contains deadlines from the EEOC's Procedural Regulations. These deadlines include the last day for the EEOC to receive a charge regarding an alleged violation, the last day to request that the EEOC review an FEP agency decision and the last day to bring a civil action after a right-to-sue notice has been issued.

CompuLaw's California Fair Employment and Housing Act rules cover claims brought before the California Fair Employment and Housing Commission. The rules contain deadlines from the California Fair Employment and Housing Act (FEHA, Government Code §12900 et seq.) as well as from the Procedural Regulations of the Fair Employment and Housing Commission (Title 2, Division 4, Chapter 4 of the CA Code of Regulations). These rules govern the practice and procedure in matters before the Fair Employment and Housing Commission, including unlawful practices actions and housing discrimination claims.

"New rules like the EEOC discrimination set help our clients stay at least one step ahead of new regulations as they relate to, among others, housing discrimination claims within California and at the federal level," said David J. Kalmick, President and CEO of CompuLaw LLC.
