the courts just recently adopted separate patent local rules to handle the increasing number of patent infringement cases that are being filed;

**U.S. Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims:** A long awaited release was this new rule set. The Court has exclusive jurisdiction to provide judicial review of final decisions by the Board of Veterans' Appeals, an entity within the Department of Veterans Affairs;

**U.S. Bankruptcy Court - District of Wyoming - District Court Rules:** Cover bankruptcy rules for the state of Wyoming.
